Big, bold Napa Valley cabernet sauvignon is the preferred wine for many fathers, especially now that grilling seasons is upon us. These favorites, including allocation-only and single-vineyard varietals, represent the best of the best. Try sipping your favorite in the new <u>Riedel Winewings</u> glasses. ## 2016 Chateau Montelena Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

Chateau Montelena may be most famous for their chardonnay beating French Burgundy to win the "Judgment of Paris" wine competition in 1976, but their 2016 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon is a sleeper hit too. Pressed from the best grapes from Chateau Montelena's Calistoga estate, winemaker Matt Crafton has created an opulent vintage with a bright red berry and floral nose, hinting at deeper nutty and woodsy flavors to surface over a couple decades in the cellar.

Every week, Crafton hosts <u>Instagram Live</u> sessions, where he leads viewers through virtual tastings, cellar tours and vineyard visits. Chateau Montelena also offers virtual one-on-one tastings where guests can connect with one of Montelena's live, virtual hosts for an appointment tailored to your personal wine preferences.
